NEWS you need to know:

** **Tow plane** is back in service.

- ** The PW-6 will be moved to Crystal Airport on 05/30/2021, returning 09/04/2021.
- ** The Board has approved new member Russell Babb.
- ** Treasurer: Year to date: 12/01/20 to 04/30/21: Income: \sim \$25K; Expense: \sim \$31K; Net Profit: \$6K.
- ** Reminder: Only schedule one (1) slot per week on the flight scheduling page; please do not schedule the whole month at one time.

Presidents Message: The President emphasizes that CSI keep <u>flying safe</u> and watch out for gliders and the tow plane when you are on the field.

Continuing with **Covid-19** issues and Riverside County health restrictions, directives and a club requirement; all members to wear a mask on the field. Wipe the planes down inside and out, **before and after** you fly.

Flight Ops.: Per the AOM, the area between the runways are NOT for landing unless an *emergency*. Gliders land on the runway ONLY.

When you are at the 3K' level make your intentions known; "going to land", "continuing to fly", etc. let the ground know what you're planning on doing.

Maintenance: Update: A radio has been installed in N3097M. N3097M will have her annual sometime in May during the weekdays.

New Business:

This is a Riverside Airport requirement.

When you enter the airport gate ONLY ONE VEHICLE at a time is allowed into the field. Wait until the gate closes, then use your FOB to open the gate.
